- 1) Coordinate transportation details to Zoe McCraw (Matrix) at 973-240-1800. She will provide recommendations on air/ground transportation and target arrival time.

Houma Accommodations

Bayou Getaway – Private residence (maps to location attached)

Until specifically directed, do not go to the Incident Command Center or contact the staff of the Wildlife Section. They have their hands full. You will receive your ID badges and field assignment the next morning.

Field Gear – You should bring the following:

- Rubber-soled mid-calf-to-knee high boots (light colors are best if already owned)
- Several sets of lightweight field clothes (long-pants; shorts; short and long-sleeved shirts). Both the residence, barge, and land facility offer 24-hr turn-around laundry services.
- Sun-block
- Binoculars, digital camera (if you have them; do not purchase)
- Field pack, rain gear
- Matrix will provide you with a light-weight broad-brim field hat.
- **Do not bring hard hat, steel-toed boots, hip-or chest waders**
