Summary

- \$50 Million Program that provides funding for construction-ready flood control projects through a competitive grant process.
- Subsequent rounds may provide an additional \$150 million for a total of \$200 million.

Eligible Entities Open to municipal and county governments in Atlantic, Bergen, Cape May, Essex, Hudson, Middlesex, Monmouth, Ocean, or Union Counties. Regional coordination on projects is encouraged.

Award Amount Up to \$15 million per project. Limit 3 projects/applications per applicant.
